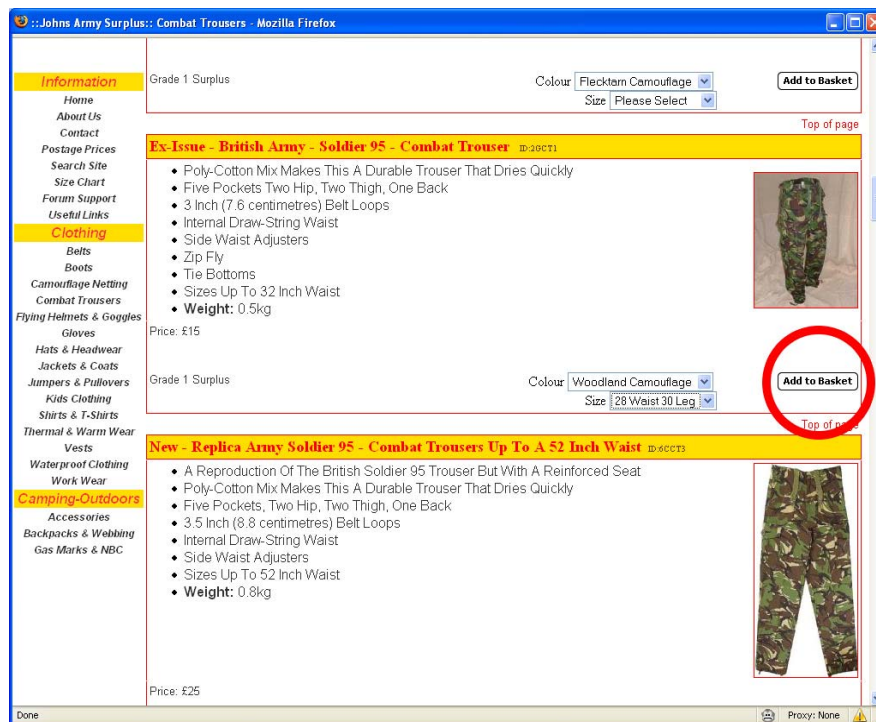


INTERNATIONAL POSTAGE GUIDE:

We here at Johns Army Surplus have tried to make a simply way to send parcels to anywhere world as easy as possible. To send your packages we would be using the Royal Mail's standard land postage. This can take any where between two, four and eight weeks depending on your countries location (We aim to deliver your item within two weeks in Western Europe, four in Eastern Europe, and eight outside Europe), we chose to use this service because it gave the best valuable postage for you the customer. Unfortunately due to the postal service that we use we are unable to supply good to Chad

To benefit all the countries that we supply too we have had to change the way we used to do our parcel rates, here are some simply instructions on how to add the right postage so your order is quickly dispatched to you the customer.

After choosing what objects or object you wish to purchase from our stock range your have to first add them to your basket, (for demonstrative purposes we have used a pair of ex-issue British army soldier 95 combat trousers) you add them to your basket by clicking on the "Add to Basket" icon normally positioned under the items gallery photo.



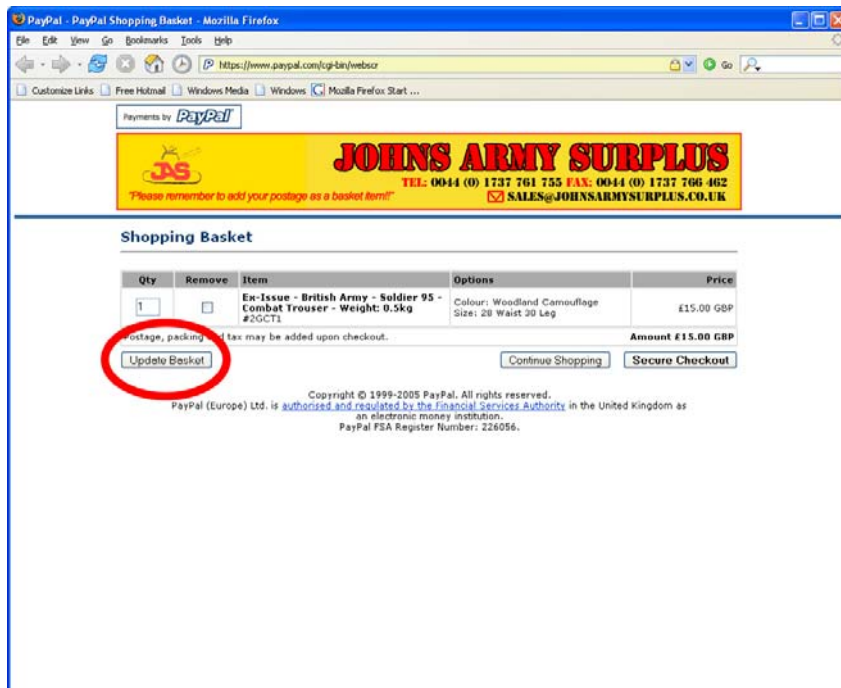
Once you have chosen what item you wish to buy, you add it to you basket by clicking the "Add to Basket" icon

When you have added the item to your basket you can check that it's been entered into your shopping basket by clicking the "View Cart" icon which is always located on the top right of every page. Once the icon is clicked a new page will be opened this is your direct link to your PayPal shopping basket.



Clicking the "View Cart" icon at the top of every page opens a separate browser window letting you view what items you have in your PayPal shopping basket

If you buy more items you can always click the "Update Basket" icon on this page and it will refresh your basket to revise the contents within it. You could minimise this page so you can keep a eye on what you are buying or it can be closed at any time you have no need to fear that this will lose all that you are ordering as all this information is kept safe until you are ready to buy the items.



If you purchase more items you can at any time hit the "Update Basket" button and this will refresh the basket page

What you should have noticed whilst you were on the PayPal page the item that had been selected has now become visible as well as the price also being shown, along with the price each item has its weight shown, this is important to keep a record. The weight will be shown in the items description on the PayPal page as well as in every description of every item shown on the JAS website.

Should you now have decided that you are finished with your buying and wish to now select your postage and pay for your items, all you have to do is simply go to the postage page via either the floating menu on the left hand side of almost every page or via the menu that accessible along the bottom on every page.

Once the page has loaded should you have to add the weights of your object it can be done here via the calculator, but as the item we chose for example purposes is below 2kg then all we would have to do is scroll the page down to the correct part of the page namely the international postage section, and then select the country that item is to be posted to. From there you simply click on the "Add to Basket" icon of the desired country and it will be added to PayPal basket. For example if you click on the "Add to Basket" under the "Belgium" tab then "2kg postage to Belgium" will be instantly be added to your JAS shopping. If however the weight of your items are over 2kg please scroll down to your country whilst on the JAS postage page select your countries "Add to Basket" icon, then once the PayPal page has loaded up change the qty of the postage from 1 to 2 or however much the postage has

to be increased by, remember we charge to the nearest 2kg weight this is to get the best possible postage rate for the customer.
